MassSave Community Education Grant

Recently, the Town of Athol was awarded a MassSave Education Grant to further promote available energy-efficiency programs available through MassSave. Please see attached with this letter a set of brochures related to potential assistance to further energy-efficiency related improvements to your apartment.

The Athol Town Energy Committee will be providing information about the various MassSave and National Grid incentive programs at a number of community events during the rest of 2023. These include the Athol Fourth Fridays that will be held on June 23, July 28, and August 25 on Main Street in Downtown Athol. In addition, we plan to hold a series of workshops during the Fall 2023 months, one of which will be targeted towards multi-family dwelling units. We also will have a booth at the September 30th and October 1st 2023 Garlic and Arts Festival in Orange.

If you are an Athol income-eligible resident (please see the “MassSave Lean Providing Energy Assistance Income-Eligible Massachusetts Residents flyer), you would need to contact the Making Opportunities Count, Inc. (MOC) agency (formerly Montachusett Opportunities Council), based in Fitchburg to request energy efficiency and weatherization assistance, as well as other energy-related assistance, such as fuel assistance. MOC serves the Town of Athol as our local Community Action Program (CAP) Agency.
